We would like to say a HUGE Thank you for all of your support and involvement with the 'Polly Parrot' home activity. Not only is the book looking fantastic with your lovely photos but the children's description of sounds is improving dramatically which is fantastic news as this is one area of the E.Y.F.S (Communication & Literacy - recognising and responding to familiar sounds) that we have to cover. We look forward to Polly's next adventure!

At nursery we encourage safe and healthy practice and one of the things that we do to help achieve this is ask the children to brush their teeth after lunch. If all parents/carers, therefore could ensure that their child(ren) have a toothbrush and toothpaste at nursery that would help us greatly.

Now Winter has arrived the Ladybirds will be engaging in activities linked around the movie Frozen, which I'm sure many of your little ones are familiar with. If your child has any 'Frozen items' please feel free to bring them into nursery to share with their friends during group/circle time. A fantastic way to develop the children's language & literacy skills I'm sure you'll agree? The children will also be painting pictures for our 'Frozen' display. To continue the 'frozen' theme the children will be exploring different frozen items such as jelly, ice cream, strawberry whip, ice cubes as part of malleable play. They will be timing how long

things take to melt to enhance their numeracy skills and observing the changes as part of understanding the world area of the curriculum.

Staying on the Winter theme the children will be learning about Winter and the changes that happen at this time. They will use different shaped potatoes to create some winter collages. The Ladybirds will also be using their fine motor & hand/eye coordination skills to cut out their very own snowflakes. Please look out for our Winter display. If you have any 'winter themed items' at home please bring them in so that we can create a Winter themed table – thank you.

February starts off our year of celebrations, beginning with St Valentine's day which we will celebrate on Friday 13<sup>th</sup> February. For this we will all be dressing in red so please send your child in to nursery wearing something red on this day. The children will have the opportunity to make love heart biscuits and cards and will be involved in lots of red messy play!

Shrove Tuesday is on 17<sup>th</sup> February so it's only right that we spend time eating some yummy pancakes with various toppings. The children will be busy decorating pancake pictures and developing their gross motor skills with a 'toss the pancake race'!!.

On Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> February we will be celebrating Chinese New Year (Kung Hei Fat Choy), Year of the Sheep. We will be playing with chopsticks, and spend time tasting some Chinese foods during snack time. The role play area will be turned in to a Chinese restaurant to extend their learning and imagination.

At the beginning of March the Ladybirds will focus on a new topic - 'homes'. The children will be looking at different types of houses and how each one is different. The role play area will be changed in to a 'home' which will allow the children to use their imaginations to imitate roles they see around their homes. Linked to this theme we will be reading the story - Three Little Pigs - and get creative designing their own stick, brick and straw houses. Keep your eyes peeled for the new ' Highwood

Estate' which we will display in the art room!!! The children will also go on a walk in the local area to explore different types of houses and look at the different shapes of windows.

Also in March we will be celebrating St David's Day, making some daffodils and decorating our own Welsh flags.

Mother's day falls on Sunday  $15^{th}$  March so look out for some special treats coming home that week - but that's all we can say at the moment!

Finally please can you check at home to see if you have any spare nursery clothes as our supply is running very low - thank you.
